

Estado 29 Orphanage Partnership Visit
July 21st – July 28th, 2018
A Ministry of the Outreach Committee

The 2018 Estado 29 Orphanage Partnership Visit will bring a group from the Westminster community to Ensenada, Mexico. While in Ensenada, we will share in the life of that community. We'll work, play, practice faith, worship, laugh, and cry with the children living at Estado 29. This experience will transform you and change your life as you encounter Jesus in the lives of the Estado 29 children and youth as well as the adults who care for them.

Purpose:

1. To continue to develop our partnership covenant (renewed Feb. 2016)
2. To assess the state of past collaborative projects and cast vision for future ministry opportunities.
3. To expand the base of people within Westminster who can be advocates for the orphanage across various ministry areas.
4. To participate in projects to improve the facilities of the orphanage.
5. To participate in activities with the children of the orphanage similar to VBS.
6. To engage in the spiritual practices of worship and prayer in a small community setting.

Participant Criteria

1. Open to all Westminster church family who have completed 6th grade (at the time of the trip) and older.
2. Youth who have not yet completed 9th grade (at the time of the trip) must be accompanied by a parent or a guardian approved by both the parent(s) and Associate Pastor for Worship.
3. The trip is limited to 30 people.

EXPECTATIONS

1. Desire to grow spiritually
2. Attendance at trip preparation meetings and post-trip debriefing.

*Excused absences (2) are permitted for irresolvable conflicts but will entail makeup projects equal to what was missed at the team meeting.

3. Competence in cross-cultural travel and interaction
4. Relational skills in being part of a group
5. Timely completion of all forms/materials for the trip
6. Participate in learning projects during preparation phase
7. Participate in any fundraising efforts for the trip that may be scheduled

TRIP COST

The cost to each participant is \$400. **Once deposits are made and money is paid out from the church, the church cannot refund individuals' deposits in the event of a participant cancellation. It is your responsibility to purchase travel insurance.**

Deposit #1: \$200 due at 1st meeting on 3/11

Deposit #2: \$200 due by 4/8

ITINERARY

A specific itinerary will be made available closer to the trip. In general we leave early in the morning on the day of departure and return around 8pm on the return date. **All team members are responsible for transportation to and from the airport.** While in Mexico, we remain on the campus of the orphanage except for one or two outings with the children.

There are 2 parts to the application:

1. An online form that includes general info as well as open-ended questions. Go to <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/PP9278X> and complete the questions. Note that some questions only apply to 1st time applicants / returning applicants. Please answer accordingly.
2. An **Agreement and Signature Form**. Please sign, date and return this form to Jon Frost.

Be aware that submitting an application does not guarantee your spot. We expect a full roster so consideration will be given to maintaining a balance of age, gender, and new/returning team members.

You will receive confirmation of your spot on the roster or the waitlist the week following the signup deadline.

Signup deadline is Sunday, February 11th .

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I need a passport? **Yes!!!, everyone must have a passport!!!**

Where do we sleep? The orphanage has guest dorms that are divided by gender. There are bunk beds with a cover sheet. You do need to pack a sleeping bag in your suitcase.

Does it matter that I don't speak Spanish? No. It does help, but there are enough translators there to help you out. It will also be part of our preparation for the trip.

Is the water and food safe to drink and eat? Absolutely. All the water for drinking is purified and all the food is bought from SMART AND FINAL, a California super-store.

Is the orphanage safe? The orphanage is a gated community in a very safe rural area, about 20 minutes from the city of Ensenada.

Do I need shots? While we do not require shots, we do recommend that you contact your family doctor or a travel health clinic for more information if you are concerned about medical issues.
