Leader: I lift up my eyes to the hills – from where will my help come?


People: My help comes from the LORD; who made heaven and earth.

People: The LORD is my keeper; the Lord is the shade at my right hand.


Leader: The LORD will keep you from all evil; the LORD will keep your life.
